

Winglts® Wallz Cast Marble Care and Maintenance

Winglts cast marble products are non-porous and commercial-grade quality. They resist mold and mildew; requiring minimal maintenance. Our products will never wear, fade or lose durability with proper care.

Routine Cleaning: Standard Upkeep

A nonabrasive household cleaner like a mild detergent solution or window cleaner is recommended to be used on your panels and pans. Rinse the shower completely after cleaning to ensure the pan is not slippery with excess product.

Shower Pan: Spot Cleaning Stubborn Stains

Winglts cast marble products are resistant to stains due to their non-porous nature. However, guests can occasionally leave a stubborn mark behind. Below are 2 options to address the stain.

Option 1:

1. On the pan's surface, use an industrial strength degreaser like Purple Power™.
2. Lightly coat with a scouring agent like Bar Keepers Friend™.
3. With a nylon brush scrub the pan's surface.
4. Rinse the surface thoroughly to remove the cleaning products and residue.

Option 2:

1. Locate the stain and apply lacquer thinner.
2. With a nylon brush scrub the pan's surface.

Shower Pan: Deep Cleaning Slippery or dingy pans

Deep cleaning is recommended when the pan accumulates build up from guest toiletries or cleaning products.

For slipperiness, first use this cleaning method on one side of the pan to test results. Step into the pan with a barefoot before and after cleaning to ensure the grip has improved.

Note: Do not do this cleaning method daily; only periodically to remove stains and residues.

1. On the pan's surface, use an industrial strength degreaser like Purple Power™.

2. Lightly coat with a scouring agent like Bar Keepers Friend™.
3. With a nylon brush scrub the pan's surface.
4. Rinse the surface thoroughly to remove the cleaning products and residue.

Repairs: Chips or cracks

While highly resistant to impact and scratches, our cast marble finish can be damaged by sharp objects or impact.

For minor chips or cracks, use the **Winglts Cast Marble Repair Kit** and follow the **Repair Kit Instructions** included with the kit.

Repair Kit Information

- The repair gelcoat is **pre-tinted** to match the specific product color.
- The gelcoat should be **mixed before use**, as pigment may settle during storage.
- The repair gelcoat is intended primarily for **solid-color finishes**. Veined or patterned finishes may not provide an exact match.
- Color match is evaluated based on the **final cured finish**.
- The gelcoat cures **tack-free** and does not require wax or PVA.
- Approximate shelf life is **3-4 months** when stored under controlled conditions, per the manufacturer's specifications.

Catalyst Required - Not Included

MEKP-9 (liquid fiberglass resin hardener) is required and is not included with the repair kit. It can be purchased locally at an auto parts store in the fiberglass repair supplies section.
